
The church does not have a mission, the mission has a church.

We are entrusted with a mission - What is the mission?

Jesus took the entire 613 laws of the Old Testament Law and broke them down to 2 simple truths: Love God and Love Others. After He was resurrected, His last instruction to His disciples was to go and make disciples. Therefore, we need to love God, love others, and make disciples.

Jesus said "If you love Me you will obey My commandments." So we demonstrate love for God by obeying his commands. To do this, we must read his word and pray (personal growth)

There is nothing complicated about loving others and making disciples, but it is hard. So we need **fellowship**



with others to encourage one another. We do this by going to church and having close intimate relationships in Life groups. We also need one-one-on-one accountability with a trusted friend to help us confess our sins and rid ourselves of unnecessary weight that keeps us from fulfilling the mission.

The blessings we receive by being obedient will naturally make us want to talk about our relationship with God and encourage others in their walk with God (**evangelism**). We have opportunity to do this by sharing our testimony, sharing the gospel and praying for others to open doors to speak into their lives.
