INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Who is one of the greatest leaders you've had the opportunity to follow?
- Would you consider yourself a leader? Why or why not?

KEY PASSAGES:

- Psalm 23 What examples of Jesus embodying this description of God can you think of?
- **John 10:11-13** When have you seen a leader act like this? What did that do to their influence as a leader?
- **Matthew 20:25-28** How have you seen people's attempts to have power or authority actually decrease their influence?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Who do you know who makes the lives of those around them better? Do they consider themself a leader?
- How can you know if a leader is serving you or using you for their own benefit?
- How do you make sure you know your "flock" of the people entrusted to your care?
- Is it possible to truly lead without knowing the people you're leading? Why or why not?
