INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- What did you think about the initial question, "Was Jesus political?"?
- Did your feelings change after you read the chapter? Why or why not?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Romans 13:1-5** How difficult do you find this passage?
- **John 18:36** What does this one answer show us about Jesus' political ambitions on earth?
- **Philippians 3:20** How does this verse put our earthly or national political issues into perspective?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- In what ways do Christians on either side of the political aisle get too focused on political matters and forget the bigger picture of what Jesus wants to do in the world?
- Have you ever seen a leader (besides Jesus) use their power, not for themselves but for the powerless? Tell us about it.
- On what political issue do you need to adopt a more Kingdom-minded attitude?
- If Jesus were in political power today, what do you think His policies would be?
