#### **Ground Rules**

### **Get Ready**

- **Decide:** If you are going out or staying in
  - If going out, choose a restaurant that would have been around in the 90's.
  - If staying in, purchase snacks, candy, or desserts from your childhood to eat while on the date.
- Whatever option you choose, make sure to take this date along with you.
- **Set The Mood:** While on your date, channel your inner DJ and find a 90's music playlist. (Spotify, Pandora, Apple Music, etc.)

#### M.A.S.H.

There is nothing more 90's than a game of M.A.S.H. (Mansion, Apartment, Shack, or House) to dream up a potential future. The good news is that you have already found the spouse of your dreams. So, we have made a few tweaks, and this version of M.A.S.H. is all about growing old together. Follow the Instructions below...

- **1.** Using the M.A.S.H game sheet, fill in each category with 4 options. Feel free to get creative with your answers. Just for fun, make one option terrible, but in a good way.
- **2.** After completing the categories, decide who will draw and who will say stop. Using the Spiral Circle, one person should start drawing a spiral, and after a few seconds the other should yell stop. Count the lines from the center to the edge of the spiral. This is your M.A.S.H. Number.
- **3.** Using your number, start with the M of M.A.S.H., and count out through the letters and all of your categories. When you finish counting, strike out the option you landed on. Now, repeat the process through the rest of the categories/letters.
- **4.** When all but one option in a category is left, circle the remaining one. When you are finished, read out your future of growing old together.

### Kickin' It Old School

One thing is true; you are not the same person you were as a teenager (thankfully!). Using the Kickin' It Old School sheet (tear in half), fill in the answers to the questions without looking at your spouses. All the answers must be how you and your spouse would have answered as teenagers. You can specify whether it's middle or high school if needed. Once finished, come back and see how well you know the teenage version of your spouse.

### Spin The Bottle Of Conversation

Find something to spin (utensil, bottle, pen, etc...). Starting at question #1, take turns spinning your item. Whoever it points closest to, must answer the question. After answering, spin again for the next question. If your item ever stops directly pointing at your spouse, you must kiss them! It's the rules! Have fun!

- **9.** What is your favorite thing in each room of our house?
- **10.** What excites you most about the coming week?


### Dare Me

In the immortal words of C+C Music Factory's Gonna Make You Sweat, "Everybody Dance Now!" Turn on your favorite 90's jam and try to recreate these classic dance moves: The Running Man, The Cabbage Patch, The Macarena, The Roger Rabbit, The Hammer Dance, or The Carlton. If you really want to be fly, try out the Kid and Play. If you have no idea what these dances are, just google it. Bonus points if you perform your sweet dance moves in public or allow your spouse to record you busting a move.

#### Keep It Going With A Date Night Fortune Teller

Follow the instructions below to make a Date Night Fortune Teller. Once finished, use it to plan out your next date night...

- **1.** Create a perfect square. Lay the paper down vertically on a flat surface in front of you. Fold the bottom left corner over so that the bottom edge of the paper is exactly in line with the right side of the page. *Images 1-2.*
- **2.** Unfold, then fold the bottom right corner over so that the bottom edge of the paper is exactly in line with the left side of the page. Now the rectangle at the top of the page needs to be discarded. Fold along the dotted line repeatedly; after 3 or 4 folds, the paper should tear easily along the fold. If you have scissors available, you can use these to cut along the dotted line instead. *Images 3-4.*
- **3.** Unfold your square. Pull the four corners of your square towards the center point. Use the intersection of the folds as a reference for where the four corners should meet. The result should look like a smaller square. *Images 5-7.*
- **4.** Flip your smaller square over and repeat step 3, folding the new corners inwards towards the middle. Grab a pen or pencil and number each of the 8 triangles now visible on your Date Night Fortune Teller. Open one flap at a time, write a different date night option on the opposite side of each number (i.e. dinner & movie, coffee, ice cream, restaurant names, etc...). *Images 8-10*.
- **5.** Close all of your flaps, then fold your Date Night Fortune Teller in half (numbers inward). Now on each of the four squares that are visible, write the name of a different color. *Image 11*.
- **6.** Open up the bottom of the Date Night Fortune Teller and push out the flaps as shown in the image. This is where you will put your fingers. *Image 12*.


