INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- What was your impression of church growing up or before you became a Christian?
- Do you know anyone who is resistant to church? What are their reasons?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Philippians 4:4** Do you know anyone who embodies this verse? Why do you think our churches don't always feel like places of rejoicing?
- **Revelation 19:6-8** How does the image of eternal worship in heaven differ from our typical expressions of worship? What could we do to make our worship more "heavenly"?
- **Psalm 9:1-2** Describe one of the most worshipful moments of your life. What habit or activity do you feel most connects you with God?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Did this week's essay change your understanding of Jesus' first miracle (water into wine) in any way?
- Do you think our current practice of worship services in the church were what God had in mind when He established it? Why or why not?
- In your estimation, how much is church about the worship experience, and how much is about community?
- Have you ever attended a church that conducted their services much differently than you were used to? What did you gain from that experience?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 91, we were challenged to ask a friend what might make church a place they'd be interested in coming. Did anyone have this conversation and what did you learn?
